Uniform Requirements:

Girls:

Uniform: Blue plaid jumper, (K-5) skirt worn to the knee (6-8)

Blouse: white or light blue

Sweater: Navy Blue sweater

Socks: All girls must wear either knee socks or ankle socks.

Shoes: Girls may wear sturdy black, brown, or navy blue school shoes. No girl may wear platform shoes. They are dangerous, most especially when climbing the stairs.

No sneakers are allowed.

Hair: neat, reasonable style, no fad haircuts; no hair coloring.

Nails: no fake or designer nails; no nail polish. Any girl who comes with nail polish or fake nails will be asked to remove them.

Jewelry: one pair of post earrings only is permitted--no hoops or dangling earrings; no bracelets, chains, or rings.

Optional Gym uniform: sweatpants and t-shirt with school logo for gym days

Boys: (K-8)

Slacks: Navy blue slacks (no baggy pants, jeans or pleated pants).

Shirts: Light blue or white shirts. (No polo shirts).

Tie: Navy blue--Kindergarten boys do not have to wear a tie.

Shoes: black, navy Blue, dark brown shoes. No sneakers or moccasins are permitted.

Hair: neat and clean above the collar. No fad haircuts, tails, fringes, lines or designs.

Boys in the junior high must be clean shaven.
